### THEODORE ROOSEVELT NATIONAL PARK

#### **ESCAPE. EXPLORE & EXPERIENCE THE BADLANDS**

When Theodore Roosevelt came to Dakota Territory to hunt bison in 1883, he was a skinny, young, spectacled dude from New York. He could not have imagined how his adventure in this remote and unfamiliar place would forever alter the course of the nation. The rugged landscape and strenuous life that TR experienced here would help shape a conservation policy that we still benefit from today. The park is comprised of three separate areas of land. The North and South Units feature scenic drives, wildlife viewing, hiking, visitors' centers, ranger-led programs and much more. The undeveloped Elkhorn Ranch Unit preserves the site of Roosevelt's 'home ranch' in a remote area along the Little Missouri River.

This 26-room, two-storey frame building was built in 1883 as the summer residence of the Maruis's family. The Chateau is now a historic house museum and contains many of the original furnishings and personal effects of the de Mores family.



# THE MAAH DAAH HEY TRAIL 150 MILES OF BADLANDS

This 150-mile trail traverses the Badlands, Little Missouri National Grasslands, private land, and the North & South Units of Theodore Roosevelt National Park. It draws people from all over the world to hike, bike, and horseback ride in the Badlands. The Trail received a 2022 Bicycling Travel Award as Best Hidden Gem in the United States.

# **ABOUT MEDORA!**



Medora began as a military cantonment called Little Missouri. It was officially named Medora in 1883 by the Marquis de Mores, an entrepreneurial French nobleman with a big dream for a meat-packing empire. He named the town after his wife, Medora von Hoffman.

That same year, a young Theodore Roosevelt made his first visit to Medora — where he would later find solace and strength after the death of his wife. Many years after that, he would tell an audience in Fargo: "I never would have been President had it not been for my time in North Dakota."

Medora is now North Dakota's #1 tourist destination!

### **DEMORES ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**



The Billings County School District has two pre-k through eighth grade schools. One is located in historical Medora and the other is located 15 miles north of Belfield along Highway 85. The school buildings are in beautiful condition and enrollments have remained stable the past three years with about 55 students at each school. The district has very involved parents, with almost 100% parental participation in parent/teacher conferences. Billings County is proud of the excellent staff employed at both schools. Both of the schools are located in small rural settings, with wonderful educational environments.










